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Grandview School K-12 Families,

I want to begin again by thanking each of you for your efforts during this trying time as we work together with you to best support your child's learning. We greatly appreciate all your efforts and support from home in helping to ensure continued learning for all Grandview School students. **I would like to share with you the plans that are in place for having students meet with teachers over the next few weeks. Individual students from K – 8 will be able to meet with their teacher by appointment only. Students from Grades 9-12 will be able to attend during the times scheduled below.** Drop-off and pick-up dates for June are also provided.

1. All new take home packages will be available for pickup on Thursday, June 4th. Please drop-off any completed material that day as well. The new packages will provide material to keep students engaged until June 10th. June 11th will be the next drop-off date. Late work can be dropped off on June 18th. Some teachers may send home additional work for the students to do if they would like to continue working until the end of June or into the summer.
2. The process for pick-up and drop-off will remain the same.

To ensure Social Distancing is taking place, we ask that families only send one adult to pick up and drop off material during the following times on the above dates.

K-3 9:00-10:00
4-6 10:00-11:00
7-8 11:00-12:00
9-10 1:00-2:00
11-12 2:00-3:00

We ask that there be only one person at each table at a time and that if you have to wait in line, that you keep 3 meters between you and others.

If families cannot make the drop-off/pick-up time, you may have someone else do this for you. If you have children with different pick-up/drop-off times, please gather all materials on one trip.

3. Families with students in **Grade K-8** will be contacted by teachers to see if you would like your son/daughter to meet with his or her teacher for a designated time (approximately 45-60 minutes). During this appointment the student and teacher may review completed work and assess areas that need to be strengthened in the next school year. Our goal is to invite each student at least once prior to the end of the year. Depending on demand, more than one visit may be arranged and small group sessions could occur later on. Parents are able to join their son/daughter in these sessions if they want, wait in their vehicle, or come back to pick their child up when the session is complete. Please leave a phone number where you can be contacted if needed. We ask that no loitering take place within the school. Students and parents are to enter through our main entrance and exit near the Nursery School.

For students in **Grade 9-12**, we have the following schedule set up.

Grade 12 10:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. – June 2nd, June 8th, June 12th, June 18th
Grade 11 10:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. – June 3rd, June 9th, June 15th, June 19th
Grade 10 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. – June 4th, June 10th, June 16, June 22nd
Grade 9 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. – June 5th, June 11th, June 17, June 23rd

If numbers allow, we will inform parents/students of opportunities to attend on other days. The times listed above for Grade 9-12 students are class sessions. Teachers will move around to classrooms to work with students. We will be following the social distance and safety guidelines provided by the province. If you would like a one to one meeting with a teacher, please email the teacher and arrange a time that works for both of you. High school students are to enter from Rose Avenue near the gym and exit by the daycare onto Rose Avenue.

It is expected that students are here to work. Anyone not adhering to social distancing policies or not completing assignments/listening to instructions will be asked to leave.

Anyone entering the building must have completed the Shared Health COVID-19 Screening Tool which can be found at <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/>

If you answer yes for your child for any of the questions in the screen, your child is to remain at home and the screening tool will provide directions as to the next steps.

Upon entering the building, students/parents will be directed to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer.
